## Vineyard Pastor's School Perm, Russia

Dear friends,

We are a little sad to report that the new pastor's school will not be able to start as scheduled. We have only had a few student applications combined with very little in the way of finances. However we remain committed to the vision and plan to use this year (along with pastoring a church) to try to do 2 important things:

- We want to visit the different Russian Vineyards this year and talk to those who might be potential students. A one-year commitment is a big step, and we feel that more dialogue is needed with people.
- We want to try forming a very specific partnership of churches in the west to help with the considerable expenses of this kind of school. Individual churches were incredibly generous last year, but we believe the load could be better carried by partnerships.

We remain convinced that the time has come for Russian students to be trained to plant Russian Vineyards. Please pray with us that this vision will go forward.

## Pray for our partner churches

Some of the Atlanta Vineyard's partner churches are going to Brazil in October to participate in "Kingdom, Worship, and Power" conferences. Let's support them in prayer.

Roger Williams of the CA Twin Cities Vineyard, Don Sciortino of Anaheim Vineyard and Randy Larson of Rockville Centre, New York and teams from each church are partnering together to minister in Brazil in October.

Oct 14 -- Twin Cities Vineyard flies to Belo Horizonte with a team of 7

Oct 15 -- Anaheim Vineyard flies to Belo Horizonte with a team of 14

In Belo they will conduct a weekend conference on Worship and the Kingdom. This will be in conjunction with several churches besides the Vineyard in Belo. The pastor's name is Celso Tavares. This is the newest Vineyard church in Brazil. Don Sciortino and Roger Williams are the speakers for the conference. They will also be speaking on Sunday morning and evening, Oct 17, at different churches.

Oct 20 -- The team then flies to Rio de Janeiro and will be joined by Randy Larson and his team of four or five from the Vineyard in Rockville Centre, New York. On the weekend of the 22nd - 24th, they will conduct a conference in Rio on Power Evangelism. The church in Rio is small, but has a lot of young, energetic and talented people who have evangelistic hearts. The pastor's name is Manga.

Oct 25 -- The teams from Twin Cities and Anaheim return home. Don and Karen Sciortino, Roger and Tricia Williams (and their 17 year old daughter Carol), as well as Randy Larson and his team, will be flying down to Florianopolis, a southern beach city for a first time Vineyard visit. Pastors Manga and Celso will also be going. Don and Karen will fly home on the 27th, while Roger and Randy will speak at a weekend conference. There will also be a couple of small "interest meetings" since this is the first time the Vineyard has been to this city. The remaining team members fly home either Oct 31 or Nov 1.
